





Why was the tool developed?

- 2016 strategic process within GIZ Headquarters
- Task Force Agenda 2030 within Group Governance, Human rights

What is the objective?

- Create a common and integrative understanding of the 2030 Agenda
- Knowledge Management for implementing the SDGs
- Efficient cooperation across departments and within GIZ

What is the status quo?

- <u>Model</u> for group was developed
- Piloting phase has been conducted successfully
- Supported by Head of GloBe-Department






2. Presentation of the 3-Clicks

What is our goal?

Make connections between SDGs, targets, internationals processes and colleagues working in different departments of the GIZ in Germany as well as abroad visible in an intuitive and easily accessible way.
